Citrix Workspace for Web is a website used as an app store. Users can open the site to securely access applications and desktops published for them through Citrix Virtual Apps and Desktops.

Notes

Evaluation Methods Used

Assistive technology products used as part of testing included Freedom Scientific JAWS 2019, NVDA 2019.1, Freedom Scientific ZoomText 2019, The Paciello Group's Colour Contrast Analyser 2.5, Microsoft Windows accessibility features, and keyboard-only control. Testing was performed with this assistive technology on Chrome and Firefox on Windows Server 2016.
